February 11-13, in New York City

- Applicants must live and teach in northeast region and must be a current member of their local/state professional association. (NYS teachers will be eligible for RBERN scholarships.)
- Each **new teacher scholarship** covers conference registration for Friday and Saturday attendance at the base registration rate of \$175. Travel, meals, and hotel are not included.
- Each **mentor teacher stipend** of \$50 may be used toward registration fees.
- New teacher applicants must be teachers with not more than 1 – 5 years’ experience, currently teaching in a school in the northeast region.
- Mentor teacher applicants must have 7 or more years of experience and must have attended at least one Northeast Conference in the past five years.
- Applicants must agree to attend the entire conference (Friday – Saturday), including a focus-group meeting (session/time tbd). Thursday pre-conference workshops are not included.
- Each scholarship winner will be paired with a mentor with the expectation that the pairs will communicate with each other prior to the conference and will meet at different times over the course of the conference to touch base and discuss conference experiences.
- The application **deadline is Monday, January 4**. All applications and letters of support must be received by this date. Applicants will be notified by January 20, 2016.
- Applicants should request a signed and scanned letter of support from their immediate supervisor to provide confirmation of employment, a comment of support, and confirmation that the applicant will be allowed release time to attend the conference. This letter will be uploaded with the application (link below). You must have this letter available to upload at the time of application.
