Puerto Rican/Hispanic Youth Leadership Institute

Each year students from the Capital Region are selected to participate in the Annual Angelo Del Toro Puerto Rican/Hispanic Youth Leadership Institute in Albany. The Institute's purpose is to foster the leadership skills of Latino students and to introduce them to New York State's legislative process. College scholarships are awarded to seniors on a competitive basis at the conclusion of the Institute. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade and must be Latino/Hispanic descent. The Institute is a collaborative effort among the NYS Senate/Assembly Puerto Rican/ Hispanic Task Force, New York State Education Department, Office of Bilingual Education, ASPIRA of New York, the New York City Department of Education and the Regional Bilingual Education Resource Networks. This year's Institute is scheduled to be held from March 23-25, 2013.

During the three-day Institute in Albany, students participate in leadership activities, network with high school students from across New York State, participate in a mock assembly, interact with legislatures and attend a Student Recognition Dinner. In preparation for the Institute a local training program sponsored by the RBE-RN is conducted.

(From EngageNY.com) Public feedback on the Progressions will be incorporated into the final recommendations to the Board of Regents. Once approved by the Board, the framework will guide the future development of P-12 Bilingual (e.g. ESL and NLA) curriculum modules. The Progressions can be used for the development of local school district curricula, and for the development of Phase II of the NYSESLAT exam's alignment to the Common Core (including ensuring the exam can support five levels of language progressions).
