



## Online Advanced Certificate in Childhood Education for ESOL Teachers

### *7th Cohort begins in 2020*

Based on the success of the past six cohorts, we have extended the opportunity for ESOL certified teachers to earn a Childhood Education certificate (Grades 1 – 6) through our NYSED-approved online advanced certificate program.

- ✓ Participants will be able to complete their coursework by the end of Spring 2021:
  - a) Cohort 7a starts January 2020 with one course, completing coursework in four contiguous semesters
  - b) Cohort 7b starts July 2020 with two courses, completing coursework in three contiguous semesters.
- ✓ Successful completers of this 17-credit program will be recommended for NYSED certification through LIU Hudson.
- ✓ Cohort members will be afforded a 45% tuition reduction.

### *Eligibility*

Certified ESOL teachers who already hold a Master's degree.

### *The program\**

The 17 credits are comprised of five 3-credit courses and a 2-credit supervised teaching and seminar.

- ✓ The instructors are experienced teachers at both the university and K-12 levels who have undergone rigorous training in online instruction.
- ✓ The classes will be online and asynchronous with many opportunities for participants to engage in discussion with classmates and instructors.

- ✓ Proof of prior certification in ESOL
